Travel Directions to Sheffield

Directions to Sheffield from various UK Cities

By Car

Birmingham → Sheffield

Distance: 90 miles (145 km)

Time: 1 hr 45 min

Route: Take M1 north via M42 and A42. Exit at Junction 33 for Sheffield Parkway (A630) into the city centre.

Bristol → Sheffield

Distance: 170 miles (275 km)

Time: 3 hr 15 min

Route: Follow M32 → M4 (east) towards London. Take M5 (north), then M42 → M1 (north). Exit at Junction 33 (A630 Sheffield Parkway).

Cardiff → Sheffield

Distance: 180 miles (290 km)

Time: 3 hr 30 min

Route: Take M4 (east) to Newport. Follow M50 → M5 (north). Join M42 → M1 (north) to Junction 33.

Glasgow → Sheffield

Distance: 250 miles (400 km)

Time: 4 hr 30 min

Route: Take M74 (south) → M6 (south). At Junction 30, take M62 (east) → M1 (south). Exit at Junction 33 (A630) to Sheffield.

Leeds → Sheffield

Distance: 35 miles (55 km)

Time: ~1 hr

Route: Take M1 (south) from Leeds. Exit at Junction 33 (A630 Sheffield Parkway).

Liverpool → Sheffield

Distance: 75 miles (120 km)

Time: ~2 hr

Route: Take M62 (east) → M1 (south). Exit at Junction 33 for Sheffield.

London → Sheffield

- Distance: 165 miles (265 km)
- Estimated Time: 3 hours

Route: Leave central London via the A41 or A1(M) northbound. Join the M1 motorway heading north towards Leeds/Sheffield. Continue on the M1 for approximately 150 miles. Exit at Junction 33 for Sheffield Parkway (A630). Follow the A630 directly into Sheffield city centre.

Manchester → Sheffield

Distance: 40 miles (65 km)

Time: 1 hr 30 min

Route: Take A57 (Snake Pass) or A628 (Woodhead Pass) east into Sheffield.

Newcastle → Sheffield

Distance: 140 miles (225 km)

Time: 2 hr 45 min

Route: Take A1(M) south → M1 (south). Exit at Junction 33 (A630) to Sheffield.

Nottingham → Sheffield

Distance: 40 miles (65 km)

Time: 1 hr

Route: Take M1 (north). Exit at Junction 33 (A630) into Sheffield.

All trains arrive at Sheffield Station (Sheaf Street, S1 2BP).

Location

Sheffield Station is 5–10 minutes' walk from the city centre. Supertram runs a service from the train station and the nearest stop to the Town Hall is the Cathedral, it is then a 3-minute walk up Fargate to the Town Hall.

There are several multistorey car parks in the city centre. The cheapest is the Moor Market Car Park (S1 4QW) this is a two-minute walk to the Town Hall. The blue dot in the Peace Gardens is next to the Town Hall.

The train station is bottom right. The Cathedral is at the top and slightly left at the map for those using the tram. The nearest car park is the NCP on Wellington Street; bottom left on the map.
